God relates to each of us differently

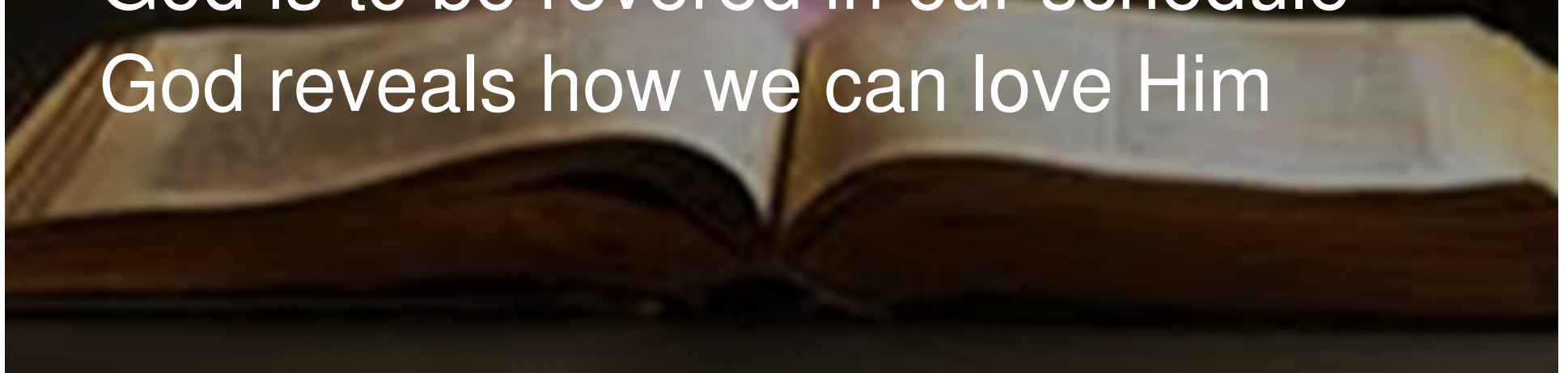
God is above all so-called gods

Relationships must respect God's blessings


God reveals how we can love others
